

for the duration of the time of closing set forth herein.

Because the Court expects all public buildings within Effingham County to be closed for an indeterminate period of time, the Court is unable to designate another facility for the transaction of court business. Should the State of Emergency extend beyond the closure period indicated above, the Court will make a determination of an available, appropriate facility for the conducting of court business when it is appropriate to do so.
