

ORDER EXTENDING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY

The judicial emergency declared by the undersigned for Thursday September 26, 2024 and Friday September 27, 2024 is hereby extended through and including Monday September 30, 2024. Although the Rockdale County Courthouse and the Juvenile Court are both scheduled to open on Monday September 30, 2024, due to the fire at Biolab, conditions are such that an extension must be placed into effect. Rockdale County has issued a shelter in place Order. Therefore, all the provisions of the Order of Judicial Emergency, including but not limited to those related to suspension, tolling, extension, and relief from deadlines or other time schedules or filing requirements imposed by otherwise applicable statute, rules, regulations, or court orders, whether in civil or criminal cases or administrative matters are incorporated into and made a part of this Order and will remain in effect through Monday September 30, 2024. Rockdale County Courthouse is scheduled to open at the normal time on Tuesday October 1, 2024.
