

Inclement weather conditions resulting from the impacts of the 2024 named hurricane Helene have resulted in hazardous roadway conditions within the county of Forsyth. Therefore, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-60(2) a “judicial emergency” exists in the county of Forsyth and the Bell-Forsyth judicial circuit. The county courthouse, and all annexes to the county courthouse, shall remain closed beginning at 2:00 P.M. on September 26, 2024, and shall remain closed until 12:00 P.M. September 27, 2024, when normal courthouse operations shall resume. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-62, all court deadlines, time schedules, filing deadlines and requirements are extended or tolled, as may be appropriate, for the duration of the above-referenced emergency courthouse closure.
