

ORDER EXTENDING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY

The judicial emergency declared by the undersigned for Monday September 30, 2024, out of an abundance of caution, is hereby extended through and including Friday October 4, 2024. Although the Rockdale County Courthouse and the Juvenile Court are both scheduled to open on Tuesday October 1, 2024, due to the gas clouds caused by the fire at Biolab, conditions are such that an extension must be placed into effect. Rockdale County has issued a shelter in place Order. Therefore, all the provisions of the Order of Judicial Emergency, including but not limited to those related to suspension, tolling, extension, and relief from deadlines or other time schedules or filing requirements imposed by otherwise applicable statute, rules, regulations, or court orders, whether in civil or criminal cases or administrative matters are incorporated into and made a part of this Order and will remain in effect through Friday October 4, 2024. Rockdale County Courthouse is scheduled to open at the normal time on Monday October 7, 2024.
