SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The undersigned Chief Judge of Superior Courts for the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit of the State of Georgia, as defined in and pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-60, and acting in accordance with the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 38-3-60, *et seq.*, and U.S.C.R. 45, it is hereby declared that this Court is confronted with a continuing judicial emergency. Therefore, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-61, the undersigned, Chief Judge of the Superior Courts of the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit, does hereby declare the existence of a continued Judicial Emergency in the counties of Chattahoochee, Harris, Marion, Muscogee, Talbot, and Taylor.

The nature of this emergency is due to a winter storm which has affected this judicial circuit since 12:01 a.m., on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, including Wednesday, January 22, 2025, 11:59 p.m., **and continuing to Thursday, January 23, 2025, 11:59 p.m.**

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the following Courts/Courthouses in the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit: Chattahoochee, Harris, Marion, Muscogee, Talbot, and Taylor County Superior, State (Muscogee), Magistrate, Probate, Juvenile, and Municipal (Muscogee) Courts shall continue to be closed for business Thursday, January 23, 2025. Records Court (Muscogee County) shall be closed for business Thursday, January 23, 2025, except as specified in separate order for essential judicial proceedings as directed by the Chief Records Court Judge. Thereafter, the above-named Courts in the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit shall reopen for business on Friday, January 24, 2025, at their regular/respective times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-62, the Court hereby suspends, tolls, extends and otherwise grants relief from all deadline or other time scheduled or filing requirements imposed by otherwise applicable statutes, rules, regulations, or court orders, whether in civil or criminal cases or administrative matters, including, but not limited to:

1. A statute of limitation;
2. The time within which to issue a warrant;
3. The time within which to try a case for which a demand for speedy trial has been filed;
4. The time within which to hold a commitment hearing;
5. A deadline or other schedule regarding the detention of a juvenile;
6. The time within which to return a bill of indictment or an accusation or to bring a matter before a grand jury;
7. The time within which to file a writ of habeas corpus;
8. The time within which discovery or any aspect thereof is to be completed;
9. The time within which to serve a party;
10. The time within which to appeal or to seek the right to appeal any order, ruling, or other determination;
11. The time within which hearings must be held in stalking and family violence cases and all ex-parte relief is continued until next scheduled hearing in said matter; and
12. Such other legal proceedings as may be determined to be necessary.

The relief granted herein expires at 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, January 23, 2025, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

The Court expects all public buildings within the Circuit to be closed for an indeterminate period of time, the Court is unable to designate another facility for the transaction of Court business. Should the state of emergency extend beyond the closure period indicated above, the Court will make a determination of an available, appropriate facility for the conduct of court business when it is appropriate to do so. 
