

Due to winter-weather conditions which are expected to result in hazardous roadway conditions, a "judicial emergency" is hereby declared pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-60. This Order shall affect the operations of all courts within the Bell-Forsyth Judicial Circuit.

As a result of this judicial emergency, the county courthouse and all annexes to the county courthouse shall be closed from 8:30 a.m., January 10, 2025 until 8:30 a.m., January 13, 2025, or until such other time as directed by the undersigned. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-62, all court deadlines, time schedules, or filing deadlines are extended or tolled during the duration of this judicial emergency.

The Circuit Court Administrator shall ensure that the Sheriff of Forsyth County, or the Sheriff's designee, shall post a copy of this notice, and any amendments thereto, on the courthouse doors. The Circuit Court Administrator shall also ensure that the County Manager, or his designee, shall post a copy of this notice and any subsequent modification or extension of this Order by posting same on the county website or other appropriate public address system.
