Judicial Council of Georgia to Meet on August 21, 2026

Atlanta, GA — The Judicial Council of Georgia will meet for a General Session on Friday, August 21, 2026, beginning at 10:00 a.m. at the Nathan Deal Judicial Center in Atlanta. Presiding Justice Sarah Hawkins Warren will preside over the meeting. The Council will consider reports from several committees, including Legislation, Budget, Technology, Judicial Workload Assessment, Georgia Case Management System, Access to Justice, ARPA Funding, and Grants.
